### **STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT**

- **SWEEPING**

Sweeping will be done based on the micro seal schedule below and for pavement management only.

- **MICRO SEALING**

Street Operations will begin micro sealing the following streets as shown in the schedule below. Flaggers will be present to direct traffic, and lanes/roads will be closed as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.

- **PATCHING**

Street Operations will be patching potholes and curblines throughout the City in preparation for upcoming Pavement Management Project, this may require intermittent

lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

- **PAVEMENT MARKINGS & ROAD STRIPING**

Beginning Tuesday, June 21, 2022, the Street Operations Department crew will begin repainting crosswalks and arrows throughout the City. The work will continue for the remainder of the season. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please expect delays while work is being performed.

- **TREE TRIMMING**

Operations crews will be trimming trees throughout the city in preparation for the upcoming pavement treatments. This may require intermittent lane and/or road closures as work is performed. Motorist are advised to expect delays in the area.

➔ **WATER LINE INSTALL – NORTH HAYES AVENUE**

Beginning Monday, May 9, 2022 crews from the City of Pocatello Water Department will be replacing the water mainline on Hayes Avenue between Gould St. to Whitman St. (Project to Last Approximately 22 Weeks). The project will start at the intersection of N. Hayes Ave. and Gould continuing southeast towards Whitman. Crews will work between the hours of 6:30 AM to approximately 5:00 PM. Monday through Thursday. During the project, access to the construction area will be restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while workers are digging. Every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during the day. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties. The project is anticipated to take twenty-two weeks to complete but due to unforeseen circumstances, the work schedule may change.

**ADA CURB RAMP & SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS ON CLARK STREET**

Beginning Friday, July 14, 2022, MS Construction will be conducting ADA curb ramp and sidewalk improvements on Clark Street between 19th and 2nd Ave. The project will last approximately 6 weeks, but due to unforeseen circumstances (such as concrete shortages), the work schedule may change. The project will start at the intersection of 19th Avenue and Clark Street, continuing Southeast towards 2nd Ave. Crews may work between the hours of 6:30 AM to approximately 6:30 PM, Monday through Friday. During the project, access to active construction areas will be restricted and sections of the street will be reduced to one lane. Every effort will be made to

provide local access to the area, but alternate routes are suggested. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during the day. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties. Caution in work zones is advised. ## ➔ CONTRACTORS

**STARR CORPORATION**-Beginning Monday, May 2, 2022, Starr Corporation will be working on a steam tunnel replacement project expected to take approximately 4 months to complete. This will require S. 8<sup>th</sup> Ave., from Martin Luther King Jr Way to E. Lovejoy St., to be closed during construction. Detours will be posted. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

**INSITUFORM TECHNOLOGIES**-Beginning Thursday, July 7, 2022, Insituform Technologies will begin the CIPP lining work throughout the City of Pocatello for the sanitary sewer mainline rehab. The project is expected to take approximately 3 weeks. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

**B&G PLUMBING**-Beginning Saturday, July 9, 2022 through Wednesday, July 20, 2022, B&G Plumbing will be renovating the Starbucks in Idaho State University's Library. They will tie grease intercept drain lines into the sewer lines. This will require temporary road closures on Martin Luther King Jr. Way, between S. 9<sup>th</sup> Ave. and Memorial Dr., as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

**STARR CORPORATION**-Beginning Wednesday, July 13, 2022 through Monday, August 15, 2022, Starr Corporation will be conducting lift station upgrades, bypass pumping, and an install of a 4" sewer line, valve vault, and high pressure line. There will be temporary road closures across Grandview Avenue, on W Whitman Street, and on the alleyway closest to the Portneuf River. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.
