



## **ROAD CLOSURES & TRAFFIC REPORTS**

### **STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT**

#### **SWEEPING**

Street sweepers are currently performing their annual spring clean-up. During this time, crews will sweep each street in the city once. After clean-up is complete, crews will then move to their regular sweeping schedule.

Regular sweeping schedule:

- Monday: Northend
- Tuesday: East Side
- Wednesday: Fairway
- Thursday: West Side

#### **PATCHING**

The Street Operations crew will be patching potholes and curblines throughout the city in preparation for upcoming pavement management projects. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

#### **PAVING**

The Street Operations crew will be paving on W. Alameda Rd. from Hawthorne Rd. to Pole Line Rd. on Sunday, July 23, 2023 from 5 AM until completed. The road will be shutdown while work is being performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

#### **PAVEMENT MARKINGS**

Beginning Monday, May 22, 2023, the Traffic Operations crew will begin repainting crosswalks and arrows throughout the City. The work will continue for the remainder of the season. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please expect delays while work is being performed.

### **WATER DEPARTMENT**

#### **WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – WYETH, BUCHANAN, AND LANDER**

Beginning Tuesday, May 16, 2023, until approximately August 2023, crews from the City of Pocatello Water Department will be replacing the water mainline on Wyeth, Buchanan, and Lander. The project will start at the intersection of Wyeth St. and Lincoln St. connecting to Lander St. and Lincoln Ave. via Buchanan Ave. Crews will work between the hours of 6:30 AM to approximately 5 PM, Monday through Thursday. During the project, access to the construction

zone will be restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while workers are digging. Every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during working hours. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties.

**SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE**

Crews will be jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the city. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work.

**I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE PROJECT**

Beginning Wednesday, August 10, 2022, Chubbuck Rd. will be closed between Pleasant View Dr. and Fairgrounds Rd. as part of the I-86/I-15 System Interchange project. This portion of Chubbuck Rd. will remain closed until Fall 2024 for roadway and bridge construction activities. A detour directing traffic around the closure via New Day Parkway/Northgate Parkway is in operation. **MORRIS EXCAVATION – PHILBIN & KINGHORN INTERSECTION**

Beginning Monday, July 24, 2023 through Tuesday, August 8, 2023, Morris Excavation will be working on a sewer mainline installation at the intersection of Philbin Rd. and Kinghorn Rd. The road will be shutdown from 7 AM – 7 PM each day with a detour provided, and will reopen at night. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

**D CO CONCRETE LLC – S. 5<sup>TH</sup> AVE.**

Beginning Monday, July 10, 2023 through Friday, August 25, 2023, D Co Concrete will be working on the S. 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. safety improvements project. There will be temporary road closures on the east lane of S. 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. from the S. 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. exit to Jason Ave. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

**CANNON BUILDERS – CARSON ST. BRIDGE**

Cannon Builders will continue to work on the Carson St. bridge until August 2023. Crews will be replacing the Carson St. bridge that runs over the Portneuf River, between Foothill Blvd. and N. Grant Ave. The bridge is now open for traffic, however, construction will continue on the side lines. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

**SUNROC CORPORATION – HAWTHORNE RD. & W. QUINN RD.**

Beginning Monday, May 15, 2023 through Monday, August 21, 2023, Sunroc Corporation will be reconstructing the intersection of Hawthorne Rd. and W. Quinn Rd. to install a traffic signal. The intersection of Hawthorne Rd. and W. Quinn Rd. will be shutdown until the project is complete. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.
