STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their regular sweeping schedule.

- Monday: Northend
- Tuesday: East Side
- Wednesday: Fairway
- Thursday: West Side

MICRO SEAL

Valley Slurry Seal will be micro sealing the streets as listed below. Flaggers will be present to direct traffic and lanes/roads will be closed as work is performed, with restricted access to residents. There will be no parking allowed on these streets from 6:30 AM – 5 PM or until work is completed. Vehicles parked on the street will be towed to the nearest side street. Residents are asked to clear the road in front of their house of any obstructions (i.e. basketball hoops, garbage containers, etc.) The schedule may be changed due to unforeseen circumstances such as weather or breakdowns. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.

PATCHING

The Street Operations crew will be patching potholes and curblines throughout the city in preparation for upcoming pavement management projects. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

PAVEMENT MARKINGS

Beginning Monday, May 22, 2023, the Traffic Operations crew will begin repainting crosswalks and arrows throughout the City. The work will continue for the remainder of the season. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please expect delays while work is being performed.

➔ **WATER DEPARTMENT**

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – WYETH, BUCHANAN, AND LANDER

Beginning Tuesday, May 16, 2023, until approximately August 2023, crews from the City of Pocatello Water Department will be replacing the water mainline on Wyeth, Buchanan, and Lander. The project will start at the intersection of Wyeth St. and Lincoln St. connecting to Lander St. and Lincoln Ave. via Buchanan Ave. Crews will work between the hours of 6:30 AM to approximately 5 PM, Monday through Thursday. During the project, access to the construction zone will be restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while workers are digging. Every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during working hours. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties.

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Crews will be jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the city. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work.

➔ **IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT**

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE PROJECT

Beginning Wednesday, August 10, 2022, Chubbuck Rd. will be closed between Pleasant View Dr. and Fairgrounds Rd. as part of the I-86/I-15 System Interchange project. This portion of Chubbuck Rd. will remain closed until Fall 2024 for roadway and bridge construction activities. A detour directing traffic around the closure via New Day Parkway/Northgate Parkway is in operation. MORRIS EXCAVATION – PHILBIN & KINGHORN INTERSECTION

Beginning Monday, July 24, 2023 through Tuesday, August 8, 2023, Morris Excavation will be working on a sewer mainline installation at the intersection of Philbin Rd. and Kinghorn Rd. The road will be shutdown from 7 AM – 7 PM each day with a detour provided, and will reopen at night. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

SORENSEN COMPANIES INC – MCKINLEY AVE. & W. ALAMEDA RD.

Beginning Monday, August 7, 2023 through Friday, August 11, 2023, Sorensen Companies will be building the Google Fiber network via microtrench. There will be temporary road closures in the north lane from 900 McKinley Ave. to 760 W. Alameda Rd. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

NALDERS ENTERPRISES – JEAN ST.

Beginning Wednesday, August 9, 2023 through Friday, August 11, 2023, Nalders Enterprises will be digging and installing a new sewerline and waterline on Jean St. The road will be closed to thru traffic from Monte Vista Dr. to Lucille Ave. until work is completed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

SUNROC CORPORATION – HAWTHORNE RD. & W. QUINN RD.

Beginning Monday, May 15, 2023 through Monday, August 21, 2023, Sunroc Corporation will be reconstructing the intersection of Hawthorne Rd. and W. Quinn Rd. to install a traffic signal. The intersection of Hawthorne Rd. and W. Quinn Rd. will be shutdown until the project is complete. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

D CO CONCRETE LLC – S. 5TH AVE.

Beginning Monday, July 10, 2023 through Friday, August 25, 2023, D Co Concrete will be working on the S. 5th Ave. safety improvements project. There will be temporary road closures on the east lane of S. 5th Ave. from the S. 5th Ave. exit to Jason Ave. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

DASCO OF IDAHO – E. LANDER ST.

Beginning Monday, July 31, 2023 through Thursday, August 31, 2023, Dasco of Idaho will be hanging fiber on existing poles along E. Lander St. There will be temporary road closures on E. Lander St. from N. 5th Ave. to N. 9th Ave. Once a block is completed crews will reopen that section and move to the next block. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

CANNON BUILDERS – CARSON ST. BRIDGE

Cannon Builders will continue to work on the Carson St. bridge until August 2023. Crews will be replacing the Carson St. bridge that runs over the Portneuf River, between Foothill Blvd. and N. Grant Ave. The bridge is now open for traffic, however, construction will continue on the side lines. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.
