➔ **STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT**

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their regular sweeping schedule.

- Monday: Northend
- Tuesday: East Side
- Wednesday: Fairway
- Thursday: West Side

FOG SEALING

The Street Operations crew will be fog sealing the streets as listed below. Flaggers will be present to direct traffic and lanes/roads will be closed as work is performed, with restricted access to residents. There will be no parking allowed on these streets from 6:30 AM – 5 PM or until work is completed. Vehicles parked on the street will be towed to the nearest side street. Residents are asked to clear the road in front of their house of any obstructions (i.e. basketball hoops, garbage containers, etc.) The schedule may be changed due to unforeseen circumstances such as weather or breakdowns. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.

- University Dr (19th Ave to Terry St)
- Trapper Ct (EOP (cul-de-sac) to Summit Dr)
- Trevor St (Greenfield Dr to Andrew St)
- Saunter Ln (EOP (south cul-de-sac) to Trekker Ridge)
- Remmington Rd (EOP (cul-de-sac) to EOP (Ridgewood))
- Yale St – ALL (Stanford Ave to Princeton Ave)

PATCHING

The Street Operations crew will be patching potholes and curblines throughout the city in preparation for upcoming pavement management projects. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

PAVEMENT MARKINGS & ROAD STRIPING

Beginning Monday, May 22, 2023, the Traffic Operations crew will begin repainting crosswalks and arrows throughout the City. The work will continue for the remainder of the season. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please expect delays while work is being performed.

➔ WATER DEPARTMENT

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – CHAPEL, MEADOWBROOK, AND HILINE

Beginning Monday, August 21, 2023, crews from the City of Pocatello Water Department will be replacing the water mainline on Chapel, Meadowbrook, and Hiline. The project will take approximately six weeks to complete. The project will start at the intersection of Hiline and Meadowbrook, and will continue down Chapel Rd., to be completed at the intersection of Chapel and Yellowstone. Crews will work between the hours of 6:30 AM to approximately 5:00 PM, Monday through Thursday. During the project, access to the construction zone will be restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while workers are digging. Every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during working hours. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties.

WATER POLLUTION CONTROL

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Crews will be jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the city. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work.

➔ IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE PROJECT

Beginning Wednesday, August 10, 2022, Chubbuck Rd. will be closed between Pleasant View Dr. and Fairgrounds Rd. as part of the I-86/I-15 System Interchange project. This portion of Chubbuck Rd. will remain closed until Fall 2024 for roadway and bridge construction activities. A detour directing traffic around the closure via New Day Parkway/Northgate Parkway is in operation. SUNROC CORPORATION – HAWTHORNE RD. & W. QUINN RD.

The intersection of Hawthorne Rd. and W. Quinn Rd was reopened to the public on Wednesday, August 9, 2023. Be advised that there still may be intermittent lane closures and use caution as the intersection is operating as a 4-way stop until the signal poles can be installed in the spring of 2024. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

M & S DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION – E. CENTER ST.

Beginning Thursday, August 24, 2023, for approximately three to five weeks, crews will be installing sidewalk sections, and updating sidewalks and ADA ramps on the south side of E. Center St. between 13th Ave. and 19th Ave. as part of a Pedestrian Improvement Project. This may require intermittent closures to the south lane of E. Center St. as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

MORRIS EXCAVATION – S. BANNOCK HWY.

Beginning Monday, September 25, 2023 through Friday, October 20, 2023, Morris Excavation will be installing water tap, curb, and gutter along S. Bannock Hwy. There will be lane shifts and lane closures north of Lundberg Ln. on S. Bannock Hwy. as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

MICHELS PACIFIC ENERGY – W. QUINN RD.

Beginning Wednesday, September 27, 2023 through Friday, October 13, 2023, Michels Pacific Energy crews will be removing overhead power transmission crossarms, wire, and poles along W. Quinn Rd. between Pole Line Rd. and Philbin Rd. The eastbound lane of W. Quinn Rd. will be closed as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

The 600 block of S. 1st Ave. will be closed during the event from noon to midnight. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in this area.

Historic Downtown Pocatello is hosting “Food Truck Round Up” every Monday from 2-9 PM beginning May 8, 2023 through September 25, 2023. The event is located at the 100 block of S. Garfield Ave. in front of the Marshall Public Library. This area will be closed during the above referenced times. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.
