➔ **STREET OPERATIONS DEPARTMENT**

SWEEPING

Street sweepers are currently performing their regular sweeping schedule.

- Monday: North end
- Tuesday: East Side
- Wednesday: Fairway
- Thursday: West Side

MILLING & PAVING

Beginning Monday, October 30, 2023, the Street Operations crews will be milling and paving the roads listed below for the Water Department mainline project:

- E. Chapel Rd. (from Palmer Ln. to Meadowbrook Ln.)
- Meadowbrook Ln. (from E. Chapel Rd. to Hiline Rd.)

Crews will work from 6:30 AM to approximately 5:00 PM each day. The roads will be CLOSED while work is performed. No pedestrians or motorized vehicles will be allowed on the roadway. Please use alternate routes and expect delays in the area. In the event of bad weather or unforeseen circumstances, work may be rescheduled to the following workday or another future date.

CATCH BASIN REPLACEMENT

Beginning Monday, October 30, 2023, the Street Operations crews will be replacing a catch basin at the intersection of W. Eldredge Rd. and Pole Line Rd.

W. Eldredge Rd. will be closed between Pole Line Rd. and Bryan Rd., there will be lane closures on Pole Line Rd. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area. In the event of bad weather or unforeseen circumstances, work may be rescheduled to the following workday or another future date.

TRAFFIC SIGNAL CABINET REPLACEMENT

On Wednesday, November 1, 2023, the Street Operations crews will be replacing the traffic signal cabinet at the intersection of Pocatello Creek Rd and northbound I-15. The signals will be inoperable and the intersection will be controlled by stop signs during the project. Motorists are advised to drive with caution and expect delays in the area. In the event of bad weather or unforeseen circumstances, work may be rescheduled to the following workday or another future date.

On Thursday, November 2, 2023, the Street Operations crews will be replacing the traffic signal cabinet at the intersection of Center St. and southbound I-15. The signals will be inoperable and the intersection will be controlled by stop signs during the project. Motorists are advised to drive with caution and expect delays in the area. In the event of bad weather or unforeseen circumstances, work may be rescheduled to the following workday or another future date.

PATCHING

The Street Operations crew will be patching potholes and curblines throughout the city in preparation for upcoming pavement management projects. This may require intermittent lane closures and possible temporary road closures as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in these areas.

PAVEMENT MARKINGS & ROAD STRIPING

Beginning Monday, May 22, 2023, the Traffic Operations crew will begin repainting crosswalks and arrows throughout the City. The work will continue for the remainder of the season. There will be intermittent lane closures while crews are painting. Drivers are advised to watch for traffic control to stay safe and avoid driving through fresh paint. Please expect delays while work is being performed.

➔ WATER DEPARTMENT

WATER MAINLINE REPLACEMENT – GARRETT WAY, MADISON, COLORADO, AND MAPLE ST.

Beginning Monday, October 9, 2023, crews from the City of Pocatello Water Department will be replacing the water mainline on Garrett Way, Madison Ave., Colorado Ave., and Maple St. The project will take approximately five weeks to complete. The project will start at the intersection of Garrett Way and Madison Ave. and continue down to Maple St. The project will start again from the intersection of Garrett Way and Madison Ave and continue towards Colorado St. via Garrett Way. Crews will work between the hours of 6:30 AM to approximately 5:00 PM, Monday through Thursday.

Early November the Water Department will return to winter hours and the crews will be working 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM. During the project, access to the construction zone will be restricted and sections of the street will be completely closed while workers are digging. Every effort will be made to provide local access to the area when possible. Parking will also be restricted in the construction zone and residents are asked to park all vehicles away from the area during working hours. At the close of each day, access will be restored to all properties.

➔ WATER POLLUTION CONTROL

SEWER MAINLINE MAINTENANCE

Crews will be jetting and cleaning sewer mainlines throughout the city. Motorists may experience delays or lane closures while crews are performing the work.

➔ IDAHO TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

I-86/I-15 SYSTEM INTERCHANGE PROJECT

Beginning Wednesday, August 10, 2022, Chubbuck Rd. will be closed between Pleasant View Dr. and Fairgrounds Rd. as part of the I-86/I-15 System Interchange project. This portion of Chubbuck Rd. will remain closed until Fall 2024 for roadway and bridge construction activities. A detour directing traffic around the closure via New Day Parkway/Northgate Parkway is in operation. SUNROC CORPORATION – HAWTHORNE RD. & W. QUINN RD.

The intersection of Hawthorne Rd. and W. Quinn Rd. was reopened to the public on Wednesday, August 9, 2023. Be advised that there still may be intermittent lane closures and use caution as the intersection is operating as a 4-way stop until the signal poles can be installed in the spring of 2024. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

M & S DEVELOPMENT AND CONTRUCTION – E. CENTER ST.

Beginning Thursday, August 24, 2023, for approximately three to five weeks, crews will be installing sidewalk sections, and updating sidewalks and ADA ramps on the south side of E. Center St. between 13th Ave. and 19th Ave. as part of a Pedestrian Improvement Project. This may require intermittent closures to the south lane of E. Center St. as work is performed. Motorists are advised to use caution and expect delays in the area.

CARSON PLUMBING AND ELECTRIC- E. CARTER ST.

On October 31, 2023, Carson Plumbing will be replacing the chiller in the ISU Physical Science Building. E. Carter St. will be closed from S. 7th Ave. to S. 8th Ave. between 6:00 AM to 2:00 PM. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and expect delays in the work areas.

NEIGHBORHOOD TRUNK OR TREAT- FOXMORE ST.
